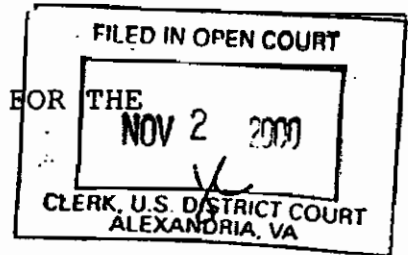

INDICTMENT

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

Count 1

- (g) One Winchester .308 caliber FN rifle
- (h) One Luger 9 mm caliber Cobray pistol
- (i) One Colt .45 auto caliber MK IV pistol

all of which had been shipped and transported in
interstate and foreign commerce.

922(g)(1) and 924(e)(1).)

Count 3


THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:


On or about July 7, 2000, in Alexandria, Virginia, in the Eastern District of Virginia, WILLIAM KINJO SMITH did unlawfully and knowingly possess a destructive device, specifically one bottle of Pyrodex muzzle loading propellant; one grenade body; and 20 grenade ignition kits, that destructive device being a combination of parts designed and intended for conversion into a grenade and readily assembled into a grenade as defined by Title 26, United States Code, Sections 5845(f)(3), which was not registered to him in the National Firearms Registration and Transfer Record. (In violation of Title 26, United States Code, Section 5861(d) and 5871).
